

History of Roebling Suspension Bridge

The Roebling Suspension Bridge, still in use today, opened for traffic on January 1, 1867. Its 1,057 foot span made it the longest suspension bridge in the world until 1883 when the Brooklyn Bridge opened. This Cincinnati engineering marvel, named for its engineer, John Roebling, a German immigrant, convinced New York City that the Brooklyn Bridge could be built. Join us for a fascinating local history lesson of the Roebling Suspension Bridge presented by **Don Tolzmann**, Covington Cincinnati Suspension Bridge Committee historian. Learn about the bridge's construction, renovations, flood effects and the Civil War.
