- 1. Under a 75 year operating agreement signed in June 2013 Music Hall Revitalization Corporation (MHRC) is responsible for all maintenance on Music Hall. When we hear talk from groups (like the Tax Levy Review Committee and commissioners) that User Fees should be used for maintenance why would we do this if maintenance is already designated to MHRC?
- 2. Will the County be giving the \$109 million to Music Hall Revitalization Corporation for the renovation?
- 3. Is this a Grant? (If not a grant, what would this be?)
- 4. Are there plans in the works for the City and Music Hall Revitalization Corporation to cancel their lease with the City of Cincinnati?
- 5. Will the County draw up a new lease with Music Hall Revitalization Corporation?
- 6. How could the County draw up a new lease if they don't own the building?
- 7. How can the County give \$109 million away with no ownership, no control?
- 8. Is the public prepared to give a \$109 million grant? Does the public know it is a grant? Is it a grant?
- 9. How could all the process be finished within 8 days when we haven't even seen any final language?
- 10. Does the County's legal department have an end game plan (document) which isn't public? (Will you please release a copy of this today?)
- 11. What is the ownership structure of the Music Hall Revitalization Corporation?
- 12. Has the County done legal vetting on MHRC? Credit investigation?
- 13. How much is 3CDC being paid to handle renovation of Music Hall? Will the County have any defined relationship with 3CDC?
- 14. Are details available?
- 15. Who will the \$3 ticket fee paid to the Cincinnati Arts Organization go to?
- 16. Will the \$3 fee be used exclusively to pay for maintenance of Music Hall?
- 17. Or, will any of the \$3 ticket fee go towards the payment of the renovation? If not, why not?
