Under Ohio Law, all of the following are qualifying medical conditions:

- AIDS
- Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis
- Alzheimer’s Disease
- Cancer
- Chronic Traumatic Encephalopathy
- Crohn’s Disease
- Epilepsy (or another seizure disorder)
- Fibromyalgia
- Glaucoma
- Hepatitis C
- Inflammatory Bowel Disease
- Multiple Sclerosis
- Pain (chronic and severe OR intractable)
- Parkinson’s Disease
- Positive status for HIV
- Post-traumatic Stress Disorder
- Sickle Cell Anemia
- Spinal Cord disease or injury
- Tourette’s Syndrome
- Traumatic Brain Injury
- Ulcerative Colitis
